The Ever Elusive Joy

Joy becomes ever more elusive with each passing day. It is elusive in a world with ever increasing options to mimic its results on the soul. Entertainment supplants joy in this world, and this world's entertainment gets bigger and better with each passing day. Small screens and big screens, kid games and kid games played by adults, arts, music, hobbies, shopping, technology, books, travel and transportation, health and fitness, all have purposelessness. Entertainment says, "Look made monumental leaps in the past fifty years. Entertainment competes more effectively for our souls than ever before. Divinely given joy seems like an antiquated notion, too steeped in relationships and contemplation. When the weekend comes, the entertainment ramps up. When the weekend closes, the planning begins to make the next entertainment jolt even greater. Happiness provides the measure of the quality of entertainment. If we are really happy with something, or someone, or some experience, then we attempt to recreate that happiness over and over with greater impact.

Joy radiates out from a different source than entertainment. Entertainment comes from without, brought into the mind and the body for the sake of stimulating feelings of happiness in the moment. Joy comes from within the person and is irrespective of circumstances. By joy, I mean the profound sense of soul rest, satisfaction and peace. Entertainment is the distant second cousin to

joy. It mimics joy, but works differently in its method, outcome, and duration. First, entertainment mimics true joy, but with a radically different method. True joy comes from seeing God as the source of soul satisfaction. Joy is God's work from the inside out. Entertainment works from the outside in by providing temporary diversions from sorrow, despair, loneliness or over there! Now that should make you laugh, or applaud, or gasp, in awe!" The goal of entertainment is to distract from our reality. When life's realities are difficult, we seek a solace for the soul, not mere distractions. Joy works from the soul's connection with God. The Psalmist says. "Be glad in the Lord and rejoice, you righteous ones; And shout for joy, all you who are upright in heart." (Psalm 32:11) Gladness in the LORD provides the only means for true satisfaction. All entertainment is smaller and weaker than our sorrows. God is greater than anything that causes us to despair. He is no mere distraction. He is the very reason we exist.

The second difference between true joy and the diversion of entertainment is the outcome in our lives. Diversions go away but the heavy burdens of life tend to remain. "Yes! The new movie comes out today. Yes! My team won!" sound great but simply distract until the next bill hits the

mailbox and the stresses of life come rushing back in to fill the void left by the entertainment buzz. Plus, the emptiness waxes greatly when the movie stinks or our team loses. The end result is a greater soul ache than before. The outcome is a search for the next entertainment "hit" to divert us from our brokenness. In Christ, we experience joy that moves from the transient schemes of the entertainment glitz to the soul's rest. God calls us to rest in Him, to have our souls satisfied in Him. As Jesus says, "Come to Me, all who are weary and heavy-laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and YOU WILL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light." (Matthew 11:28-30) Jesus offers soul rest in the midst of the pleasures of life and in the midst of life's trials. Joy is ultimately soul rest or soul satisfaction in God through His Son, Jesus Christ. The outcome of entertainment is greater unrest when the diversion dissipates. The outcome of joy transcends our circumstances and sustains us.

The third counterfeit of entertainment in its supplanting of joy is its duration. Even if the diversion is high quality, even if the expectations are met or exceeded, even if the movie was dazzling and the team continues its winning ways, eventually the entertainment of this life ends. Life troubles grow greater and greater as we age. There comes a time when the entertainment of this life just doesn't get us to where it used to. Then, life ends. We die and with our death the entertainment dies too. Now we are left with just our soul and the presence of the God who made us. No entertaining diversions will help in this moment. However, God helps us greatly. Divinely given joy lasts forever. As the psalmist says, "You will make known to me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; In Your right hand there are pleasures forever." (Psalm 16:11) Joy is God's will for our life. God wants your joy. Ultimate joy is found in God through faith in His Son. When we know God through His Son, our soul is eternally satisfied in Him. Between now and that day when our soul fully rests in Him, may we be ever vigilant of disregarding His gift of joy for the trifles of entertainment.
